# Rosenthal Heritage Collection - Midas

For his collection "Midas" the Italian designer Gianni Cinti took reference from the Greek mythology of King Midas, who was given by Dionysos the power to turn everything he touched into gold. On the classic baroque shape of Sanssouci, he created a pattern that plays with different gradients of gold: just traces of gold, hint or full golden - like fingertips - on the plates and cups. The pattern has a handcrafted character that is explicitly imperfect in its perfection of handpainted golden lines at the handles of the sugar bowl or the coffee- and teapot.

# Rosenthal - La Chute, Squall, Fast und Geode

Fascinated by materials' plasticity and limits of deformability, French designer Cédric Ragot designed vibrant vase series for Rosenthal. Whereas the design "La Chute" takes up the big questions of creation and finiteness, his object "Squall" refers to the already successful vase "Fast" created by Ragot in 2007 and preserves a movement in all its dynamics in porcelain. In his design "Geode", Ragot combines the minerality and structure of rock blocks with a soft vase shape, creating the unity of seemingly greatest contrasts.
