Rosenthal - Paperbag vases

With the paperbag vase, Tapio Wirkkala took aim at pop culture with a wink in 1977 and created one of the Rosenthal classics par excellence. mixing it with other contrasting shades from the Sunny Day collection, Avocado Green is at its best.


Thomas - Sunny Day: Cobalt Blue, New Red, Apple Green, Yellow and Turquoise
