# On the Seaside: Stylish decoration ideas for a coastal feeling at home

#### Rosenthal - Junto: Aquamarine

Aquamarine is widely regarded as the mother of all precious stones. The name alone calls to mind not only the close connection to the shades of the sea, from pale to dark blue, but also its visual reflections, depths and shallows. The circular flowing blue shades of the Junto colour reflect water's endless diversity. Interspersed with pastel dots in beige and cream, each plate is unique. Applied to cream-coloured stoneware, Junto aquamarine combines lightness with a pleasant freshness, turning the dining table into a place of joie de vivre.

#### Thomas - Trend Colour: Ice Blue

The Thomas Trend Colour collection sets coloured accents - inspired by the nature of the North. Its colour Ice Blue lets the finely ribbed structure of plates, cups and bowls shine in a powerful turquoise blue of the Arctic. All articles of the Thomas Trend Colour collection are made of natural raw materials and are "Made in Germany". Every single item is dipped into a coloured glaze and subsequently burnt. The result is therefore always individual.

### **Thomas - Cliff: White Beach**

Like an island from a bird's eye view, appear the organic shapes of the new collection Thomas Cliff. Spanish designer Gemma Bernal captures in its forms the warm Mediterranean light, the sandy beaches and the connection between the island and the surrounding sea. The new "White Beach" glaze emphasises the harmonious curves of the island landscape. In this delicate mix of white and creme beige, plates, cups and bowls in various sizes rise

above the table surface like single small cliff coasts, and create a harmonious, dreamy look.

### Arzberg - Joyn: Denim Blue

Trendy and easy-going - the new Joyn Denim Blue colour by Arzberg is a versatile all-rounder. Like the popular blue jeans, denim is a cool everyday companion and creates a laid-back look for any occasion. On the plates, cups and bowls in various sizes, the light denim blue conveys comfort and serenity and at the same time, in combination with the soft sand beige and shimmering anthracite grey of the Joyn Stoneware collection, it unfolds a distinctive presence that always reflects the spirit of the times.


