A line structure that is broader in the centre and dissolves outwards gives the plates and cups an authentic character and a

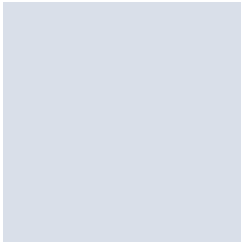
